- a task or problem engaged in usually by a group of students to supplement and apply classroom studies
- a project is a temporary endeavor undertaken to create a unique product, service or result.
- an individual or collaborative enterprise that is carefully planned and designed to achieve a particular aim.

WHAT IS A BRAVE LOVE PROJECT?

A BRAVE LOVE PROJECT IS:

- Centered around meeting the needs of others in a way that demonstrates the love of Jesus
- Has a specific goal or aim in mind. You can clearly express to others what you are wanting to do and see happen.
- Has a reasonable time period attached to it so that you can see real impact in that timeframe.
- Has opportunity for others to join you and leads to an interdependent team working together on the common goal.

JESUS COOKIES - A BRAVE LOVE EXAMPLE

There was a young woman who went to a large California university that had a well known Greek system and a whole block dedicated to fraternities and sororities. Wild parties would happen there every weekend, particularly Thursday nights, where you could always find drunk students stumbling through the streets, women under the influence being taken advantage of and even people vomiting right on the sidewalk.

Anna was a Junior and she loved Jesus! It bothered her to see so many of her peers looking for love, acceptance and a sense of belonging in all these dark places. She wanted to tell them about the love of God. She had a simple, but brave idea! She and some friends began to gather every Thursday night around 11pm to bake some cookies. They made a sign that said "Jesus Cookies," grabbed their guitars and hit the Row. They found a place on the

busy party street, passed out the still-warm cookies, sang some songs about God's love and watched as God began to move. Students enjoying the free cookies would ask about the sign and why they were there. Spiritual conversations began to happen, broken students began to pour out the pain and suffering in their lives, testimonies of God's love and goodness were shared, people got prayer, and young intoxicated women were helped to get home safely. Anna and her friends were faithful to go every week and soon had a fun reputation as the "Jesus Cookie People" as students would look for them each Thursday night. More believers joined the Jesus Cookie project and when the fall semester ended, everyone agreed to start back up after the Christmas break.

A simple desire to love the lost on Greek Row led to endless love encounters as people were drawn to Jesus through the kindness and bravery of the Jesus Cookie People.

HOW TO DISCOVER YOUR BRAVE LOVE PROJECT

1. AWAKEN TO A NEED

FOR ANYTHING THAT BECOMES VISIBLE IS LIGHT. THEREFORE IT SAYS, "AWAKE, O SLEEPER, AND ARISE FROM THE DEAD, AND CHRIST WILL SHINE ON YOU.

_EPHESIANS 5:14

From the story of Deborah in Judges 4 & 5, we learn how important it is to pray and ask God to awaken us. Deborah awakened herself only because God helped her see the need (that village life had ceased). She then stirred herself even further. She could have stopped at just seeing the need and grieving with God about it but doing nothing. Instead, God opened her eyes and she continued to awaken herself further, agreeing with what God was showing and asking of her.

Needs are everywhere! On your campus, at your work, in the community, among strangers and friends, with the young and old, those near and far. There are also many types of needs among people: for friendship, evangelism, acts of service, affirmation, provision like food/drink/clothing, discipleship, organization, teaching, leadership, safety, and on and on. There are endless ways to express the love of Jesus through seeing and meeting a need.

Take some time over the next several days to really cry out to God around the following areas:

- Ask God to awaken you in this hour for what He is going to ask you to do.
- Give God your full surrender. Your total 'YES.' Tell Him that you'll obey Him no matter what He asks of you.
- Declare out loud that no personal weakness, lack or excuse disqualifies you. God chooses who He chooses and He delights in using imperfect people to do miraculous things. He is your source of strength, wisdom, favor and strategy. You will stay in a place of dependence on Him.
- Refuse any thought to defer to some other "more qualified" woman to get the job done.
- Ask Him to open your eyes to see a need around you that He is wanting you to serve or reach. Ask Him to give you a first step!

2. TAKE THE FIRST STEP

DO NOT DESPISE THESE SMALL BEGIN-NINGS, FOR THE LORD REJOICES TO SEE THE WORK BEGIN, TO SEE THE PLUMB LINE IN ZERUBBABEL'S HAND. _ZECHARIAH 4:10

Most times God only gives us the first step! He doesn't unveil the full plan or even all the outcomes. He simply asks us to listen, hear, and obey. The first step can often seem small and insignificant. Make that phone call. Meet that person. Ask those questions. Gather your friends. Share your faith. Lead a Bible Study. Start volunteering. Do that thing you know He's asking you to do. From there, one step will lead to another and God will begin to unfold His beautiful plan for you and for how He wants you to shine His love.

Meeting the need for the one, will lead to meeting the need for the many. As you go, you'll begin to see or create opportunities for more divine connections to take place, as God begins to blow on the work of your hands and open up new doors.

3. INVITE OTHERS TO JOIN YOU

TWO ARE BETTER THAN ONE, BECAUSE THEY HAVE A GOOD RETURN FOR THEIR LABOR: IF EITHER OF THEM FALLS DOWN, ONE CAN HELP THE OTHER UP. BUT PITY ANYONE WHO FALLS AND HAS NO ONE TO HELP THEM UP. _ECCLESIASTES 4:9-10

All of us need others! It's easier to sustain and grow in bravery and step out into something new when surrounded by other women who are giving out faith, agreement, encouragement, and championing the first step that God has given you to do. God loves it when we work in team. It's good and necessary to appreciate others giftings, talents, and perspective and our impact will be greater if we love and serve in greater numbers.

Take others with you for the sake of multiplication. Invite others to see the need God has shown you, and so that they might learn what to do and can carry on to expand the work.
